- 2. Make hwldownload.sh executable.
- 3. hwldownload.sh is a bash script. Once you have changed the permissions as asked in the preceding step, run it by typing ./hwldownload.sh
- 4. Follow the conversation and use the following secret message when asked and as instructed by the script:
