


Hiding Methods From Access


- Hidden methods
 - start with an underscore
 - do not show up in help()
 - are meant to be internal (e.g. helper methods)
- But they are not restricted
 - You can still access them
 - But this is bad practice!
 - Like a precond violation
- Can do same for attributes
 - Underscore makes it hidden
 - Only used inside of methods




def __init__(self, hour, min): """The time hour.min. Pre: hour in 0..83; min in 0..59""" assert self_is_minute(m)




