- apropos look for manpages about something
- info GNU alternative to man (hypertext)

#### Security

- umask default permissions for created files
- su switch user

#### Scheduling

- cal text calendar
- crontab -e schedule timed events

## Editing on shell command-lines

- Ctrl-A = start of line (home)
- Ctrl-E = end of line (end)
- Ctrl-F/Ctrl-B = forward/backward (right/left arrow)

Works in many UNIX editing environments

## Cygwin

- Compile and run UNIX programs under Windows
- Emulates UNIX system calls
- Easy installation
- Full UNIX toolset, many applications

### X Window

- UNIX GUI
- You're looking at it (OpenOffice is an X application)
- Expects 3-button mouse
  - Ctrl-left/middle/right click on Xterm
- ssh -X

mountpoints drive letters

cd -> home cd -> no change

-options /options

 $LF (\n)$  CR-LF (\r\n)

EOF=Ctrl-D EOF=Ctrl-Z

.tar.gz .zip

.so .dll
