Replication between DBI & DB2



Replicate Some (but not all) Data






• A box is a table or a replication group (schema)



Replicate Some (but not all) Data






Updates go in both directions



Replication Configuration is Per-Site





- One queue at source for each destination
 - no matter how many tables/schemas are being replicated!
- Who has admin rights to configure replication?
- Who has INSERT privileges in queue?
 - a serious security concern!



Admin Rights



- Who has admin rights to configure replication?
 - The DBA (Adrian!)
 - Not you!
- Sorry about that ...



Workaround



- Multi-Master Replication is installed and working
- You create a script
 - to create a "master repgroup" and replicate it between the two sites
- Adrian will run it
