

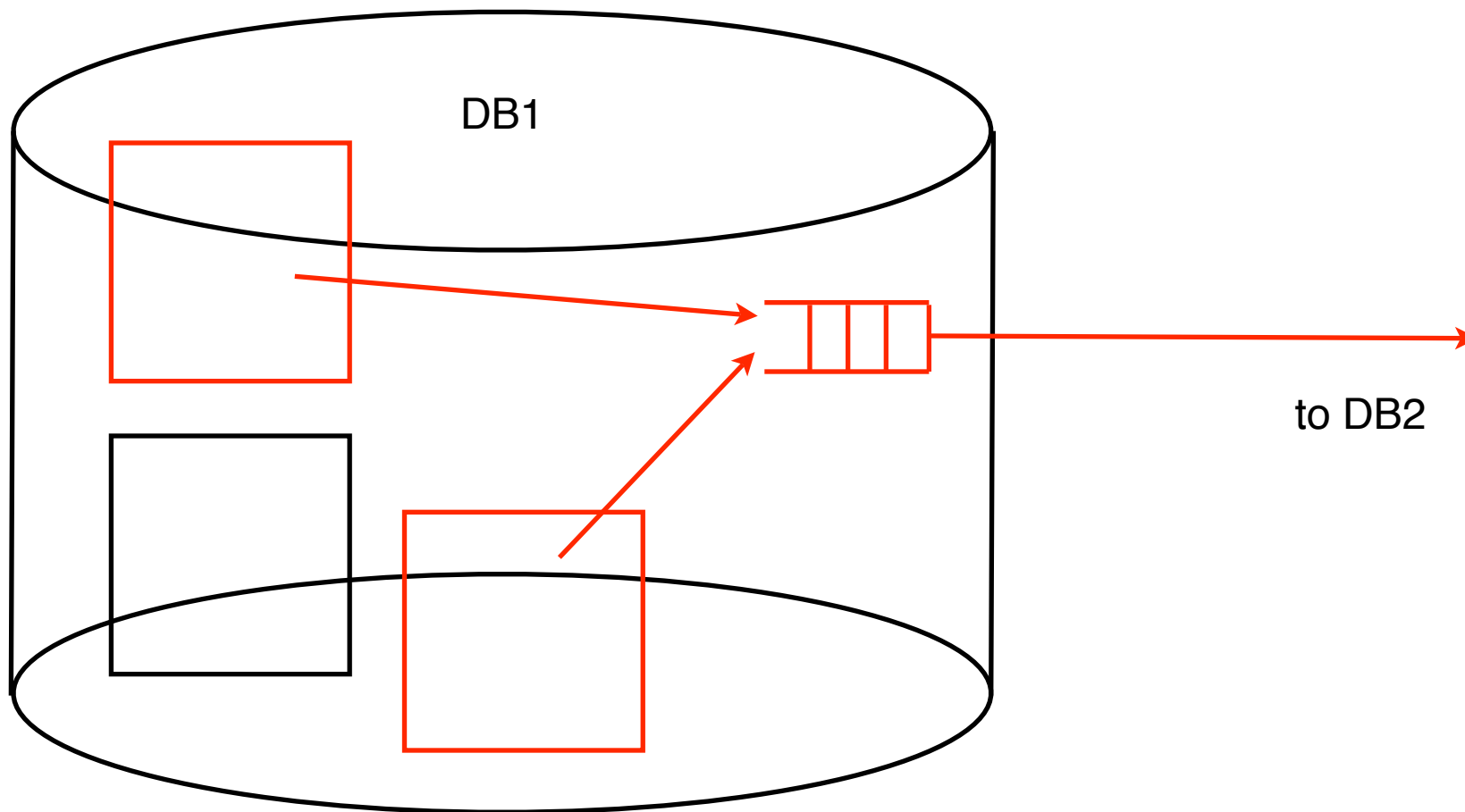

# Replication between DB1 & DB2

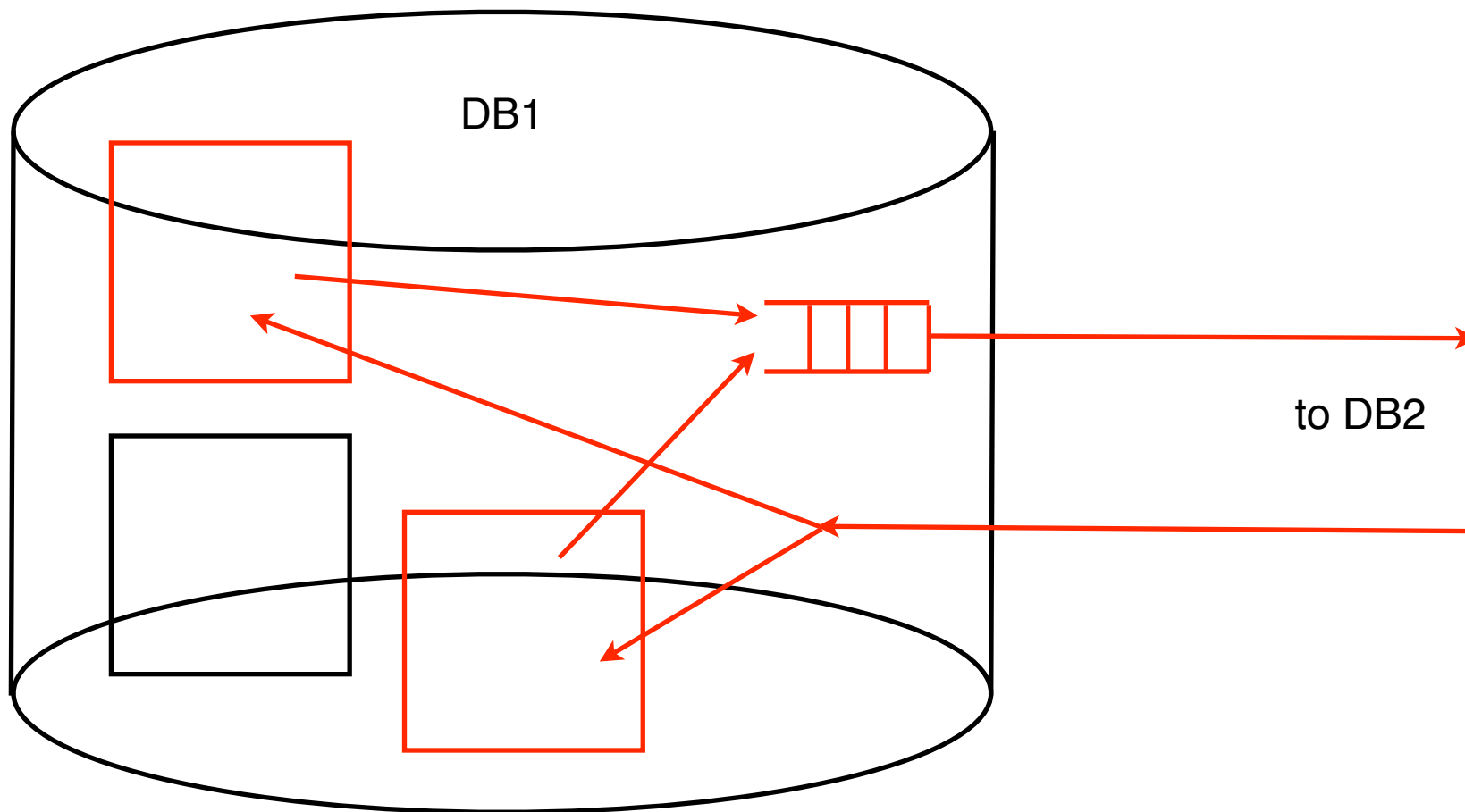
- Oracle Advanced Replication

# Replicate Some (but not all) Data



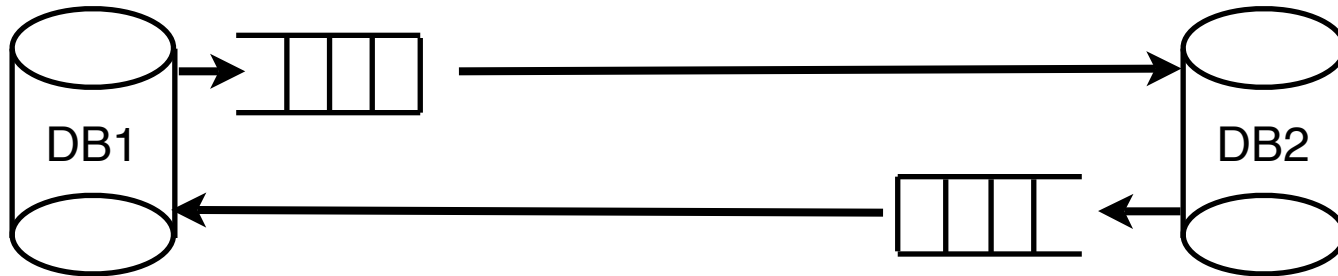
- A box is a table or a *replication group* (schema)

# Replicate Some (but not all) Data



- Updates go in both directions

# Replication Configuration is Per-Site



- One queue at source for each destination
  - no matter how many tables/schemas are being replicated!
- Who has admin rights to configure replication?
- Who has INSERT privileges in queue?
  - a *serious* security concern!

# Admin Rights

- Who has admin rights to configure replication?
  - The DBA (Adrian!)
  - Not you!
- Sorry about that ...

# Workaround

- Multi-Master Replication is installed and working
- You create a script
  - to create a “master repgroup” and replicate it between the two sites
- Adrian will run it
