Credit Requirements:

Each student MUST complete 30 credits of course work/project work

- All courses must be both technical and advanced (advanced being 4000 level or above)
- Three to six credits must be for the M.Eng. Project
- At least 15 of the 30 credits must come from CS courses that are not seminars, independent studies or the M.Eng. Project
- Of the 15 CS credits, at least two courses should be at the 5000 or above level
- At least 28 credits must be taken for a letter grade (i.e. only 2 credits may be taken s/u)
- None of the 30 credits may be counted towards another degree
- Any work that contributes to the 30 credits must begin after entering the M.Eng. program
- A GPA of at least 2.5 must be maintained throughout the program
- Courses with grades lover than a C- will not be counted towards the M.Eng. credit requirements
- A grade of 'B' or better is required for all credits associated with M.Eng project
